The Community Mayors is a not-for-profit, non-political 501 (c) (3) organization. Founded by "Wireless" Louis Zeltner in 1875 as the Locality Mayors, the organization included Teddy Roosevelt among its notable members. In 1957 the organization was reincorporated as the Community Mayors under the leadership of Dominick Della Rocca, K.M., and The Community Mayors began providing "Recreational Therapy" for children with special needs. Dominick dedicated his life to the children with special needs for 50 years. Today, under the leadership of his daughter, Shelley, the Community Mayors sponsor a series of events benefiting tens of thousands of special children. This concept provides these children with special needs activities that gets them out of hospitals and classrooms, and allows them to experience many activities that would otherwise not be available to them.

The Community Mayors membership includes business and community leaders aided by thousands of dedicated volunteers from uniformed service organizations, businesses, government and the community at large. This is one of the few organizations where all the money raised for the children goes to the children. The most amazing thing is there is no paid staff. The members, officers and volunteers give of their time freely.

Traveling south on the FDR Drive, take 23rd Street Exit and make a left U-turn underneath the FDR Drive. Continue straight on to the FDR, staying to the right.

The Water Club will be on the right.

From the Lincoln or Holland Tunnel

Take 23rd street across town to the East River.

Turn left underneath the FDR Drive and stay to your right. The Water Club will be on the right.

From the Midtown Tunnel

Take the FDR Drive South. Take 23rd Street Exit and make a left U-turn underneath the FDR. Continue straight on to the FDR, staying to the right.
